

CLASS RULES

ENGLISH CLASSES

TACK- An English style saddle must be used (Dressage, Show or General Purpose).

ATTIRE - Rider to be dressed in Hacking/Hunter coat and jodhpurs. Unless hot weather policy applies in which case the rider may wear

Boots may be long, dressage style or short and pony club style.

NOTES- English Pleasure - Snaffle bit. Cavesson noseband only or none.

No spurs or whip to be used for pleasure class.

WESTERN CLASSES

TACK - A Western style saddle and bridle must be used..

Any standard Western bit, bosal, hackamore or snaffle bit may be used. However, if curb chains are used, they must be at least one-half inch in width and lie flat against the jaws of the horse. Cavesson-type nosebands, martingales, and tie-downs are prohibited.

Shank bits, bosals and hackamores are optional to higher level of training.

Horse to be ridden one handed if using a shank bit, bosal and hackamore.

ATTIRE - Rider to be dressed in Western style clothing and boots. No helmet required for senior riders.

NOTES - Western Pleasure Morgans should have a headset that is natural and comfortable for the horse is generally slightly lower and looser than an English ridden horse. Not exaggerated to be too high or low. Severely penalised for head being below the wither.

Western classes require jog and lope to be performed.

STOCK CLASSES

TACK - To be ridden in a Stock saddle and stock bridle with snaffle bit.

ATTIRE - Rider to be dressed in stockman cut trousers, jeans or jodhpurs with a plain or light coloured shirt, tie and plain colour or tweed jacket. Akubra style hat may be worn instead of helmet for senior riders

NOTES - Patterns for these classes are set prior to competition.

TRAIL/OBSTACLE CLASSES

Tack and Attire is open for all trail events

NOTES - Obstacle Race is to be scored on accuracy and time. More details in separate document.
